- To provide an opportunity for students at EMI schools to foster inter-school exchange in theatre arts

INSTRUCTIONS

- Schools may choose to participate in Modern Drama and/or Shakespearean Drama session
- Modern Drama: Schools may choose to write their own original play or adapt one
- <u>Shakespearean Drama</u>: Schools should act out a set Shakespearean scene (either the original version or the modern version)
- Duration of the play MUST NOT exceed 15 minutes
- Schools that over-run will NOT be considered for the Outstanding Performance Award
- The host schools will provide basic furniture such as desks, chairs etc.
- Schools should prepare their own simple props and costumes
- There is no limit to the number of actors/actresses
- Schools are encouraged to use a computer for sound effects. If required, ONE pre-recorded CD is allowed
- No electronic preset lighting is allowed
- Use of computer and projection is NOT allowed except for sound effects

- The entry fee is \$1000 per school. This includes the Drama Fest entry fee and a complimentary teachers' Drama Workshop on 20 January 2018 for a maximum of <u>2 teachers per school</u>.
