Profile of Instructor -- Mill Ho

Mr Mill Ho is a drama educator, producer, director and actor. Mill received his MFA (Drama and Theatre Education) at Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts. In 1990, he graduated from HKAPA Drama School. For consecutive two years in 1989 & 1990, he received the school's scholarships and was awarded the Best Male Actor Award.

Mill has had a long and successful career in drama and acting. He was a TVB actor from 1990 to 1996. He continued his career in acting after leaving TVB and has been performing in over 200 TV, film and drama production. He has also produced and directed over 100 productions.

In drama education, he has served as the lead tutor and programme designer for over 200 schools in Hong Kong, Macau, and China. He is also a trainer at TVB Hong Kong and Red One Entertainment Academy. For the last 20 years, he has served on the judging panels for numerous drama competitions and drama festivals.

Workshop Description and Outline

The 2018 Teacher's Workshop will focus on Acting Skills Coaching and Directing.

In the first half of the workshop, this focus is on how teachers can polish students' acting skills in understanding the characters and bringing the characters to life, particularly on the use of physical and vocal skills.

The second half of the workshop explores how teachers can more effectively direct and produce a drama.

More specifically, the workshop aims at enhancing the knowledge and abilities in:

- (1) How to coach and evaluate actors
- (2) How to create a truthful character
- (3) How to train a strong and flexible body and voice
- (4) How to do good staging and blocking
- (5) How to cater drama teaching to a diverse group
