## HOW

- Schools may choose (i) to write their own original play scripts (ii) adapt a script of their choice or (iii) choose from a number of scripts prescribed by the AEMSS
- Duration of the play must not exceed fifteen minutes
- There will be no sets; only basic furniture and 2 moveable display boards will be provided
- Schools to provide their own props and costumes
- There is no limit to the number of actors/actresses
- Schools may use a pre-recorded CD for all sound effects
- No electronic preset lighting will be allowed
- Schools will be provided with 4 wireless microphones and 1 microphone with stand
- Each participating school will be assigned a classroom for preparation
